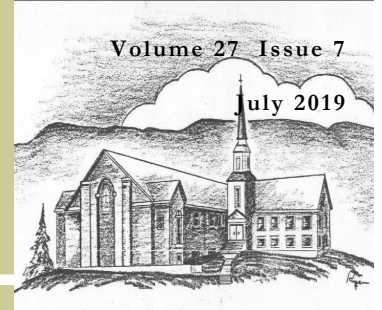

Kid's Camp—Is July 8-12!

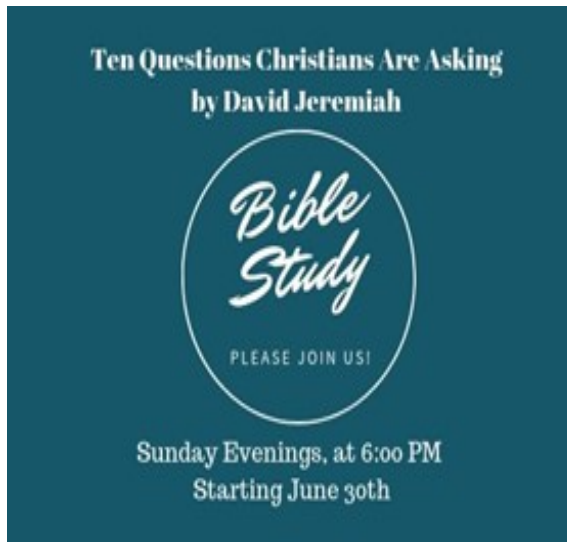
Youth Summit Camp—Is July 15th-20th!


